## Eligible Grantees by Region

### Traverse City Area

(Antrim, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Leelanau, Manistee, Missaukee, and Wexford Counties)

19 of 40 eligible grantees participated in the program last year

**\$480,744.30**  
is the total amount that eligible grantees can receive

Grantees range from a school district with nearly 9,000 students enrolled to a child care center with a capacity of 53

### Kalamazoo & Battle Creek Area

(Allegan, Barry, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph, and Van Buren Counties)

31 of 133 eligible grantees participated in the program last year

**\$2,221,568.20**  
is the total amount that eligible grantees can receive

Grantees range from a school district with 12,521 students to a Residential Child Care Institution with 17 students.

### Grand Rapids Area

(Allegan, Barry, Ionia, Kent, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, and Ottawa Counties)

48 of 173 eligible grantees participated in the program last year

**\$3,458,033.00**  
is the total amount that eligible grantees can receive

Grantees range from a school district with nearly 14,000 students enrolled to a non-public school with 9 students.

### Flint Area

(Genesee, Lapeer, Livingston, Saginaw, Shiawassee, and Tuscola Counties)

27 of 146 eligible grantees participated in the program last year

**\$2,966,980.40**  
is the total amount that eligible grantees can receive

Grantees range from a school district with 8,000 students to a Residential Child Care Institution with 13 students.

### Detroit Area

(Macomb, Oakland, and Wayne Counties)

60 of 315 eligible grantees participated in the program last year

**\$5,585,061.80**  
is the total amount that eligible grantees can receive

Grantees range from a school district with nearly 50,000 students to a Residential Child Care Institution with 5 students.
